



Here are some **IMPORTANT** final details for your field trip to see *Robin Hood*:

While the majesty of historic Pearce Auditorium is wonderful, the down side of this old building is that lobby and restroom space is very limited. Since the offices of the college deans are adjacent to the theatre, we ask **ALL** patrons (weather permitting) to stay on the steps outside to keep noise at a minimum. Here are bathroom directions for **BEFORE AND AFTER** the play:

BEST OPTION: The largest restrooms on campus are in the Burd Performing Arts Center on Academy Street a block away (see map attached, which is in the Study Guide). Your buses can stop there for 10 minutes and things can happen fast.

NEXT BEST: If you are picnicking or already off the bus and need to stop, please go into Yonah Hall (the building to the left of the theatre if you are on the lawn looking at Pearce Auditorium. Again, more space than you will find in Pearce.

LAST RESORT: If it's close to curtain time and you have just a few people who need a break, come to Pearce. If you are still outside, come in the doors of Bailey Hall (attached to the theatre and to the left) and turn right. The restrooms are on the left. If you're in the theatre, just step into the lobby and turn right.

Hope this helps everyone enjoy an uninterrupted trek to meet Robin Hood! I've also attached drop off and parking information from the Brenau Security Office so we can have a smooth, **SAFE** arrival and departure. **IF** you have a child in a wheelchair, please have the school bus drop off that child and their helper **BEHIND** Pearce Auditorium on Prior Street. This way you can avoid all stairs.
